WAY REPORT 1992-93

For the past year, WAY has suspended its operations due to a lack of interest. At the end of the former president's term in September of 1992, no new president could be found. As a result, the former president took over as caretaker of WAY's correspondence and decided not to initiate any new business or solicit membership dues.

The next step must be a major assessment of WAY's role and purpose. This should examine whether a reconstituted WAY could find a useful mission or whether other existing institutions, such as the WNGGA, could take over youth programs if WAY were disbanded. In addition, WAY has recently received a large bequest and we must decide on a suitable use of these funds. Clearly, the current situation is untenable and we must change it.
