First get a copy of the WAY constitution; SECOND--draw up a proposed amendment to the WNGGA Constitution to incorporate important points from WAY Constitution; THIRD--meet with some folks in Harrisburg on whatever weekend I go out to meet with the 2002 Venue Committee--hopefully in February or March; FOURTH--seek consensus among the folks (who will hopefully be representing WAY); FIFTH--take proposed document to WNGGA Board of Trustees in May for review. John Ellis from Green Mountain College has indicated he would be willing to meet as well as Kara Lewis from Rio Grande University plus Carolyn Kearney, the current President, plus her brother, I think, who has some responsibility with WAY. I think Meirwyn Walters might be interested too. Would you be able to come too? I'd like to keep the group to about 6 or 7 since we could get more done--we'd meet on either a Saturday or a Sunday--whichever other day I wouldn't be meeting with the 2000 Harrisburg Venue Committee. (And, of course, assuming the weather cooperates!). Classes here at Gustavus end on Wednesday with fall semester final exams on Friday, Saturday, Monday, and Tuesday. Because we are 501-c-3, we qualify to have a work study student at the Welsh Center and we know that she'll only be working for us two more days. Doesn't cost WNGGA anything since her pay is through the College. Take care...
