Dear Member of WNGGA:

I couldn't find better words to express the importance and responsibility of the nominating committee than to quote from a letter of one of its members -- "with reference to nominations it is only after some deep thought and searching for names that the difficulty in arriving at an adequate number of prospective candidates for trustees presents itself. This, in itself, is no problem for I can think of several persons who would fit into our plans very well, but they don't qualify either (1) spasmodic interest in Cymanfa affairs or (2) some interest but insufficient to qualify".

Several names however were submitted but many either declined or did not qualify, especially in the United States. It is hoped that the future will see the general membership becoming more involved in the responsibility of choosing thoroughly qualified nominees. Plans are under way to do just that.

The nominating committee respectfully submits the following as nominees and trustees in the WNGGA:

JOHN M. WILLIAMS (incumbent for Canada), completing first term and eligible for a second term. John has served faithfully and well, demonstrating considerable interest in the welfare of the association.

LYNDON JONES (Canada) who has served on the OGGA board of officers and trustees for many years.

JOHN B. K. JENKINS (Canada) who also served on the OGGA board and who has been most interested and active in the affairs of the WNGGA.

TOM EDWARDS (Canada) who is well known in Cymanfa circles as trustee and his faithful attendance to many of our functions. He is enthusiastic and quite outspoken as the occasion arises.

We would wish also to mention TAL GRIFFITHS of Ottawa but as of this date we have not had either acknowledgement or whether he qualifies under the constitution rules.

It is interesting to note that among submitted names for the United States DR. ISLYN THOMAS was submitted by the state of New York, but unfortunately the constitutional rules would have to be suspended in order for him to qualify.

The enclosed voting ballots therefore will show those qualified (mentioned above) and in addition will have two blank lines for any other nomination of your choice. There are two vacancies available for Canada and two vacancies for the Eastern United States.


Dear Jack:
