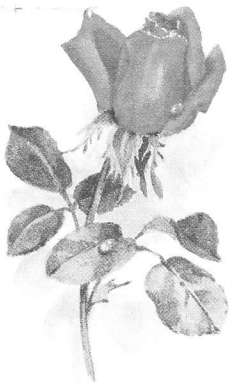

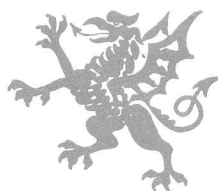

Now, since time is a great factor in the preparation of such an event I urge early response of your pleasure to accept or deny.

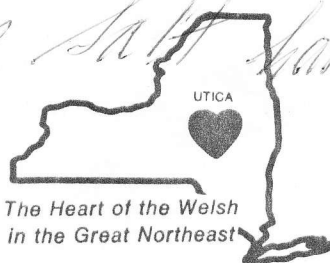



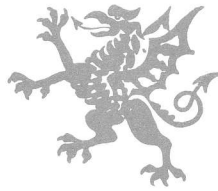

Dear Jack,

I have your letter of January 26, 1981 concerning the phone call to you from Ann Davies Thomas with regard to the possibility of a Welsh National Gymanfa Ganu in Salt Lake City, Utah.

This is a difficult letter for me to write as I have known Ann for a number of years and we have been good friends. However, as you may remember, in one of our Trustee Meetings I raised an objection to have a National Gymanfa in Illinois - or in any State - where the Equal Rights Amendment had not been passed.

Many organizations (Counties/Municipalities, Legal Associations, Medical and Health Groups, Educational Organizations, Historical Associations, Science Organizations, and a great many others) have advocated that States which have not ratified the Amendment be boycotted and no conventions be held in any of their cities. Among the Religious Groups supporting ERA are the United Presbyterian Church; the United Methodist Church, Board of Church & Society; the United Church of Christ; the Southern Christian Leadership; the National Association of College & University Chaplains; the Lutheran Church in America; the Episcopal Church, Executive Council; and the American Baptist Churches, U.S.A.

All the Equal Rights Amendment advocates is: Equality of rights under the law shall not

be denied or abridged by the United States or by any state on account of sex. (See enclosed folder put out by the American Association of University Women.)

The Mormon Church has excommunicated a 5th generation Mormon woman for working for the passage of the ERA. Furthermore, the three Western States where the Mormon influence is strong in the legislature (Utah, Arizona and Nevada) have not passed the ERA. Mormon money influenced legislators in many States, most recently in Florida. We need only three more States to ratify this amendment (38 have already passed it). The Mormon Church has used its influence with money and illegal voters, and by using half-truths and innuendos concerning this Amendment to discourage its passage.

I will never vote to have any Convention in any State which does not ratify the Equal Rights Amendment.

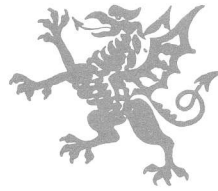

Dear Jack:

As requested in your letter of January 26, some thought has been given ^{the} possibility of the Welsh Society of Salt Lake City sponsoring the 1982 National Gymanfa Ganu.

Undoubtedly, many would be pleased to again visit Salt Lake City but there are other important things to be considered. Our chief consideration should be what is best for the Gymanfa Ganu itself.

I am aware that Toronto was planning to sponsor Gymanfa in 1982, as part of the 75th anniversary of the Welsh Church. If that invitation comes to hand within a short time perhaps it would be to the advantage of the Association to hold the 1982 convocation in Canada inasmuch as the 1981 Gymanfa Ganu will be in the United States.

Individuals in both of these groups have had experience in sponsoring a National Gymanfa Ganu and are aware of what is involved.

Since the final decision rests with Executive Committee I shall certainly concur with their action. It is my opinion, however, that in this matter, our president's preference should be given strong consideration.

Article V, paragraph b, covers the venue question that we now face. Since we did not have an offer to act upon at the Trustee meetings in Vancouver, it is my opinion that the Trustees should be reconvened and requested to make the decision based on the two offers.

Perhaps you have other information of which I am unaware, but in view of the circumstances, I would recommend consensus from the Executive Committee as to the best procedure to follow at this time.

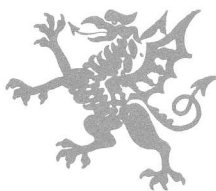

I have just returned from a three week business trip.


Regarding paragraph D of Article XII of the Constitution, I think you more qualified to accept or deny this program.
