Dear Gwen:

Our letters seem to cross in route and I'm hoping they don't pass now. Sorry that your surgery kept you from going to Wales, and we trust you are recovering in time for Christmas and possibly the trip to Wales later on.

Betty said you called concerning a billing for 100 Hymnals for the Vancouver Society which were shipped to Emmaline in Portland some time ago. Its difficult at this point in time to determine from the records just when the Hymnals were shipped and the shipping charge. However if you did in fact receive the Hymnals, I can only tell you that It would amount to \$300.00 plus shipping or postage. Quite recently I sent the same quantity to Los Angeles and the charge was \$28.58. So if you would like to consider Portland and Los Angeles about the same distance from Warren, we could resolve the matter on that basis. The total then would be U. S. currency \$328.58/payable to The Welsh National Cymanfa Gamu Association, Inc.

Would this sound reasonable? Good health to you-Betty sends her best. Sincerely,
