We have again been commissioned to serve as the Nominating Committee to present names of individuals for election as trustees at the next National Gymanfa in Kansas City, Missouri.

There will be four (4) to elect - two (2) from Canada and two (2) from Eastern United States. The second term of Edith Hill from Pennsylvania will expire and she is not eligible for re-election. Meirwyn Walters of Massachusetts will complete his first term. Ellis Griffiths of British Columbia, Canada, will complete his first term but has indicated that he does not wish to be nominated for a second term. Hedd-Wyn's second term expires and he will not be eligible for re-election.

Nelson Llewellyn received a letter from Gwenfyl Jones indicating that she would like Lynn Owens-Whalen of Western Canada to be nominated and Ellis Griffiths joins in that recommendation. The pertinent part of the letter reads as follows:

"I, Gwenfyl Jones, nominate Lynn Owens-Whalen as Trustee. (Ellis Griffiths is not going to run as trustee in 1992.) Ellis Griffiths is the seconder. It gives me great pleasure to nominate Lynn - I know her well. She will make a 1st class trustee. Lynn is in education - serves on Teachers and District Committees. She is very well informed and has excellent skills of organization and always has a wealth of ideas. We need a trustee in the Western Canada."

Subject to your approval I thought we might proceed as follows:

If we accepted Gwenfyl's recommendation to fill the vacancy left by Ellis Griffiths' retirement, Hedd-Wyn could then give us a recommendation for the other nominee from Canada. I would write to Edith Hill and ask her for a recommendation from the WilkesBarre,
