I had a letter from Mary Morris Mergenthal who was under the mistaken impression that it was the NWAFF which decided to assume responsibility for printing and distributing the subject list. I corrected her information which led to my involvement in this action. I told her in my reply that I thought that the report given at one of our trustee meetings was that she wanted to be relieved of this responsibility and the Board of Trustees voted to take on the job. It has been clarified to me that she is willing to continue; however, she can no longer bear the expense of doing so.

We have two options in carrying out the vote of the Board on this subject. (1) Mary can and will provide her list, corrected to her best ability, to you around mid-August. You can correct it, arrange for its printing and distribution, and advise Mary of corrections for update of her list for her continued use. This procedure could be followed each year supplemented with a flow of information between you and Mary throughout the year. (2) Mary can continue to do the job as she has in the past with information on corrections flowing between you. Her costs are as follows: printing of 150 copies @ \$50; collation and folding @\$10; envelopes for mailing @ approximately \$20; and first class postage and airmail to Canada @ \$80 for a total cost, even if she mailed them all, of \$160.

I think anyone of these options would carry out the intent of the Board of Trustees vote and, if I had the job, I would pick option (2). I recommend it to you as a reasonable cost for what could be a headache.

I will inform Mary on this message and hope that coordination between you will take place while I am in Europe.
