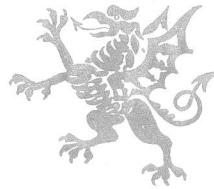

Following the usual procedure in such matters your letter will be submitted to the National Executive Committee and the Board of Trustees at their regular meetings in Chicago.


For your information the National Organization is inserting a clause in the Instructions to Sponsoring Committees calling for a report to the National Treasurer reasonably soon after the records are complete, but in no case later than 90 days after the Gymanfa is over.

With respect to the 60/40 monetary split this arrangement has been in effect since 1958 as per resolution of the Annual Meeting of that year. This subject has been discussed at Annual Meetings occasionally since that time, the most recent being in the Milwaukee meeting on September 5, 1970. After discussion and consideration it was voted to maintain the 60/40 arrangement. In my opinion, everything considered, the present arrangement is equitable to all parties involved.

We are looking forward to a wonderful Gymanfa in Chicago.
