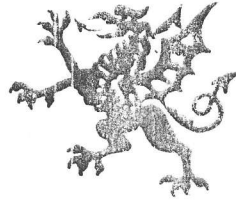

Received your note concerning the mailing of the President's letter and your "reminder" which you want to include in the mailing.



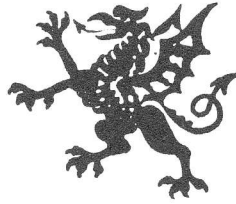

Dear Nelson,

Thanks for your note of April 17th. I received it after I returned home from spending the weekend with the Brownfields and their computer in Granville. Whew! What a session! It seems for every question we answer or every major decision we make, there are 3 more questions or decisions that follow.

You're right: we do plan to place a "reminder" letter and a revised Schedule of Events folder in the President's mailing at the end of May (or early June). Tom is working on revising the Schedule in order to pare it down to 2/3 page. Our "Land of Legend" Tours are all but sold-out. Saturday has 16 seats left, Friday has 30 seats left. So, by the time this next mailing goes out, there will be no \$25 tours available ... only the \$10 tour of Columbus.

As Tom and I discussed last weekend, we will have three more mailings to our people here in Ohio: 1) the end-of-April mailing with "Dragon Tales", "National News", info brochure, etc.; 2) the end-of-May President's mailing from the WNGGA office; and 3) the end-of-June reminder postcard about the WSCO picnic scheduled for July 13th. I think this mailing schedule will be the most efficient and least confusing for the people on our mailing list.

Regarding our mail list: we plan to put "Address Correction Requested" on the outside of all envelopes in the end-of-April mailing. This will allow us to update all current addresses before the National mailing at the end of May. I will make all necessary corrections and forward a new copy of the list just as soon as I possibly can --- probably around May 12-15. I will also send you a list of all those requests for information I have sent out to date (about 50-60 at last count).

I've also enclosed in this envelope two people to add to your mail list, as well as the current progress report on the 1986 National in Columbus. No doubt, we'll be talking again soon. 'Til then,

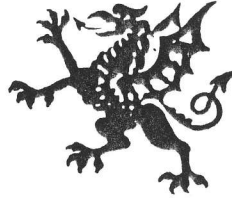
