It was a real pleasure seeing you again in New York. Janet and I thoroughly enjoyed the National Gymanfa Ganu and are eagerly looking forward to Philadelphia and Ottawa.

The entire Minnesota delegation extends to you its appreciation for your strong support for our invitation to have the National in Minneapolis in 1978. We promise that it will be a good one!

We are of course now deeply involved in the final preparations for our Minnesota-Iowa Festival on September 28. Enclosed is a copy of the Bulletin Insert which has been distributed yesterday and today to over 50 churches of this area, over 40 newspapers, and over 50 radio and television stations. An area advertising paper is planning to carry a full page "story of the Gymanfa Ganu" on the Tuesday prior to the festival and on Thursday and Friday a public radio station is going to broadcast a special interview regarding the Gymanfa Ganu. It takes some time to get this all coordinated but we are anticipating a good crowd--600 to 700 persons at each of the two sessions.

We are particularly intrigued by an "experiment" which we are trying this year--we are following the customs of Wales by sending out the list of hymns ahead of time to over 50 college and church choirs and asking them to sit in a special section in the front audience seats. We are not sure if two or twenty choirs will respond but if it works we'll of course make it a regular feature.

Sorry, but due to an emergency appendectomy in July my trip to your fair city had to be cancelled, I'm still recuperating from the surgery.

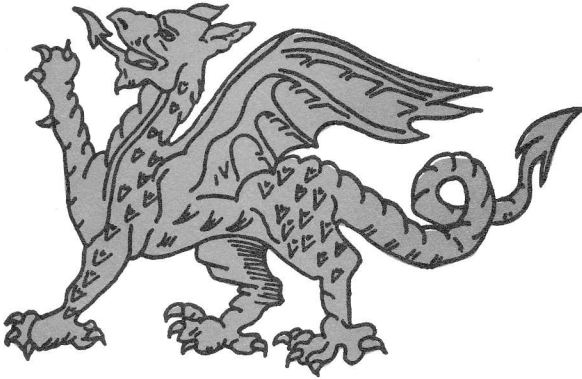

Dear Jack:

We are almost ready to make the final site selection decision for the 1978 National Gymanfa Ganu here in Minneapolis. At this stage the hotel has been chosen but it depends on a favorable rate structure which they should send me soon.

There is a strong desire among the Minneapolis Welsh community to feature a choir at the 1978 Gymanfa Ganu similar to New York City. I visited with Gwynn Parri about this in late September when he was at our state Gymanfa in St. Peter. He seemed to think that with the assistance of Milwaukee and Chicago, plus "outside" financial backers, that this would be possible. In fact he said that the Morriston Orpheus Choir had indicated to him a desire to return to this country in 1978.


I have mentioned to our local people that either the Morriston Choir or Pendyrus Male Choir would be good selections. It is my thinking that they could arrive in Minneapolis for the Gymanfa plus a concert. They could then leave here for Milwaukee and Chicago and possibly even Detroit and/or Cleveland if performances could be arranged in these cities. By working their way east in this manner, departure would then be from the last city.

The purpose of this letter is to sound out your reaction to this, ask if you could suggest any additional choirs for consideration and ask if you would know the persons would have to be contacted with these choirs. Mind you, we certainly are just in the brainstorming stage and trying to calculate the feasibility of such an undertaking. Any feedback will be greatly appreciated.
