Dear Mr. Roberts:



Dear Jack:

You will recall we discussed the matter of complimentary rooms for the officers of the Welsh NGGA - all most conveniently listed on the lefthand margin of this note-paper. I agree that all are closely involved with the work of the Association and accommodation should be provided without charge to them. How this is done with the New York Hilton may require some negotiation on my part since the standard allowance of 'free' rooms is one room for each 50 booked by the Welsh NGGA - and in this case too, Wales Week in New York - registrants at the hotel. This means that we will need 250 rooms booked to cover 5 free rooms.

My Committee also has demands upon the New York Hilton; and, we need accommodation for Terry James, Havard Gregory and Dr. Gwyn Walters at the very least. I have a few extra rooms allocated to performers but either way, money or a room has to be found.

Accordingly, my suggestion is that we finalise the hotel arrangements around August 1 - when we should have a good reading on the number of rooms booked - on friday there were 28 only. What I would like in the meantime is a listing for each of the five officers showing the day they will check into the hotel, the day they will check out and if they want a single room - otherwise, I will get them a double room. I will get Gwynn Parri one of the free hotel rooms since he will be here most of the time. Perhaps, Jack, you could fill in the information on the enclosed hotel cards but return them to me to hold until I have all our needs.

There is no question that the officers have to pay for their rooms - either the hotel provide them free or they are paid out of operating expenses.

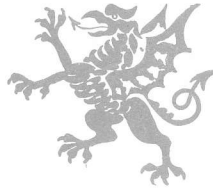
