- Price of Gas** :—The prices of gas per 1,000 cubic feet ruling at present are .....

- Meters provided by the Board**—The Board provide meters at rent and keep them in repair. The consumer is responsible for the safety of the Meter and is liable to make good any damage it may sustain from fire or other accident, or from carelessness, fair wear and tear excepted.
- Rent of Meters**—The rent of meters will be charged from the date of fixing until they are returned to the Gas Works and notice in writing to the Board should be given to remove them.
- Altering Meters**—No Meter is to be connected, disconnected or moved except by the Board's servants. Any unauthorised person in any way interfering with the meters, pipes or other fittings of the Board will become liable to statutory penalty.
- Inspection of Meters**—Officers of the Board shall have free access at all reasonable times to ascertain the quantity of gas consumed, and to examine the state of the meter and fittings.
- Defective Pipes and Fittings**—The Board will not be responsible for any loss or damage which may be occasioned by an explosion or other accident arising from the imperfect state of the Gas fittings in the interior of the buildings, or within private property.
- Escape of Gas**—It is particularly requested that whenever there is a smell of gas, immediate notice given in writing at the Office of the Gas Works and that due precautions be taken to prevent any person with a light approaching the place where gas is escaping or accumulated, especially in a cellar or other confined place.
- New Tenants**—These should give the Gas Company notice on entering into possession in order that the meter may be examined and the index read.

### SPECIAL NOTICES

- VACATION OF PREMISES**—At least 24 hours' notice in writing must be given before premises, to which the Board supplies gas, are vacated. Failure to give such notice will result in the liability to pay being continued.
- COMPRESSED AIR OR EXTRANEIOUS GAS**—A consumer using gas for working an engine, gas compressor or other similar apparatus, or using air at high pressure or gas not supplied by the Board in connection with gas supplied by the Board must give 14 days' notice to the Board of his intention to do so, and if required fix and use an appliance to prevent pressure fluctuations in the Board's mains and any inconvenience or danger to other consumers or to prevent the admission of air or gas not supplied by the Board into the service pipe or the Board's mains. The Board may cut off the supply of gas to a consumer who fails to comply with the provision of the above-named section.

### GAS ACT, 1948

**GAS TESTING**—Regulations under the above Act require an Area Board to send to any consumer at his request a copy of a statement issued by the Minister of Fuel and Power relating to the tests of gas supplied to the consumer during the preceding quarter.
