WASTE OR MIS-USE OF WATER.

NOTICE.—Should any leakage of water occur, immediate steps must be taken to remedy the waste. A supply of water for DOMESTIC PURPOSES does not include a supply of water for horses or cattle, or washing carriages or motor vehicles or a supply for any trade, manufacture or business, or for watering gardens, or for fountains, or for any ornamental purpose. It is a mis-use of water to use the supply for other than domestic purposes without paying the prescribed additional charges. The attention of Consumers is called to the provisions of Section 17 of the Waterworks Clauses Act 1863, which prescribes that : "If any person supplied with water by the undertakers wilfully or negligently causes or suffers any pipe, valve, cock, cistern, bath, soil-pan, water closet, or other apparatus or receptacle to be out of repair, or to be so used or contrived as that the water supplied to him by the undertakers is or is likely to be wasted, mis-used, unduly consumed, or contaminated, or so as to occasion or allow the return of foul air or other noisome or impure matter, into any pipe belonging to or connected with the pipes of the undertakers, he shall for every such offence be liable to a penalty not exceeding five pounds." THE BOARD HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that the provisions of this section will be strictly enforced; and that in all cases either of waste or misuse of water, legal proceedings will be taken without further warning.
