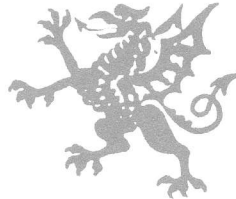

We received the information today, I thought it looked very nice, thank you very much, I wish I would have suggested that we have the election earlier on the agenda with so many to elect it may be a long process to do the counting, however maybe we can go on to the Way luncheon and announce the results on a bulletin board, or something, it is going to be a bit tight getting the crowd off to the dedication, am sure it will work out, we may be able to hold up one bus-load for the Way luncheon people.

I talked to the Marriott today and arranged for the coffee, tea, rolls, etc. for Sun. morning at 7:30 A.M. the cost will be \$2.50 each, will get a more definite count later but I told him it would be around 20 to 25 people. This price includes the tip. Also received the check from Catherine today. We also got their ad, and they sent a letter saying they couldn't get their signers together for the check but it would come later, it is all a little amusing but am sure they will get it all together, had a letter from Owen Roberts and he said there would be 8 attending from Montreal-all coming together, he has a terminally ill brother-we are certainly having a lot of this in our group-hope and pray everyone improves. Dear Emmaline:

I trust all is going well there and I look forward to a great Gymanfa. I'm sure you have had problems but your committee has been able to work around them.

The Hymnals (300 for the Portland Committee and 50 for Gwenfyl Jones) were sent from Warren on August 7, 1984 by way of U.P.S. They indicated you should receive them in about a week, and I trust they have arrived by now.

The cost to your Committee for the 300 Hymnals is \$900.00 plus a prorated U.P.S. charge of \$85.40 making a total of \$985.40. I would suggest you wait until after the Gymanfa to send me the check.

The extra 50 Hymnals are Gwenfyl Jones and she will pick them up from you for Her Society.
