1. Review these two current documents to ascertain what they contain and to see what, if anything, can be streamlined.
2. Prepare a document entitled Planning Guidelines for a National Gymanfa Ganu. After your committee has prepared this, we ask that it be sent on to the Board of Trustees for its review and approval. You may want to give the Board a draft copy for its comments prior to the preparation of a final copy.

The resulting document will provide a tremendous service to persons interested in securing information about what is involved with "planning a national."

Dates to keep in mind are April 24 (Ontario Gymanfa Ganu) when the Board of Trustees will be holding a meeting in Windsor (across from Detroit) and Labor Day Weekend in Wilkes Barre. I will simply ask Iris for a "Progress Report" at Windsor and she and you can decide what you feel can be done by Labor Day Weekend.

Each of you brings to the committee a unique background of personal familiarity with details connected with hosting a National Gymanfa Ganu. This will be your chance to make a substantial contribution to the operation of the WNGGA with a streamlined document to encourage persons who as stated above might want to host a National.
