Dear Ellis,

Sorry you had to field that one. The tape & cd issue was our Achilles heel. We contracted with the company that had done our two previous recordings, and only found out last fall that it had been sold, and to a total twit at that.

My co-chair Marietta Biggs Schumann is in charge of recordings, and may be reached at [REDACTED], Columbus, Ohio 43221.

We are doing a three tape set (each tape is different) for the price of one tape. CDs are another matter that Marietta is trying to straighten out.

If your party is unable to reach Marietta, he/she can phone Weldon Ables, our treasurer, at [REDACTED], or write to him at [REDACTED] East Dunedin Road, Columbus, Ohio 43214.

On another matter: You should either have received our first check, or will do so early this week. That check is to cover the \$5 registration fee that comes off the top; song books; hymnals; memberships; life memberships; and the printing that Nelson had done for us.

We still have three bills outstanding as they are disputed in part, and we will be sending along an almost complete report as soon as it is ready, which should be yet this week. Penry has audited our books and has certified them up to this point. He will, of course, reaudit them when everything is final. National should be pleased that not only are we in the black and able to send the \$5 registration fee, but also the reimbursables, AND a rather hefty profit.

Ohio state law allows creditors to bill up to one year from the date charges are incurred, so we will need to make final disbursement on September 6, 1999, one year to the day after our event was over. This is something that all venues should be aware of in their individual states, as it would be difficult to ask for money back, once it is disbursed.
