Alan: 1. e-mail sent to George Richards with address to which trophy should be sent. You should have already received a copy of the note to him.
2. You should have also received copies of my note to Howard Thomas and his reply. He has a good point about the delay in getting signatures. How about if they would simply list the contracts and amounts already committed and then inform you of future commitments that are within the budget. That seems to be reasonable.
3. With regard to the question about approving their increase in the Registration Fee--my remembrance is that it was not approved but I may have been distracted when the discussion was going on. Lynn is working on the notes so I don't have a reference to check other than listening to the tapes.
