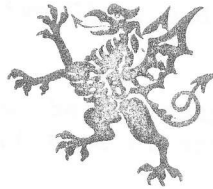

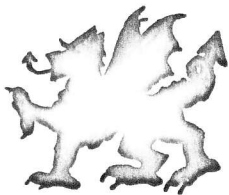


It is requested that you state by what authority both my name and address appears on the letterhead.

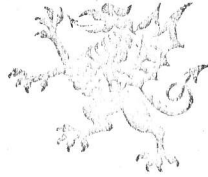


Having apparently ignored my request for information dated September 25 (letter copy enclosed) I am again appealing to you to reconsider, a courtesy which you did not extend to me.

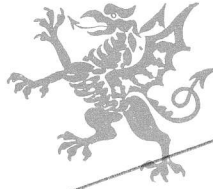

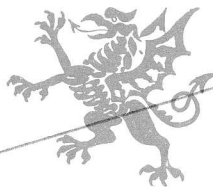
