Dear Jack:

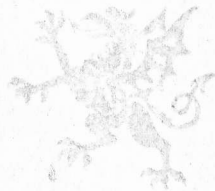

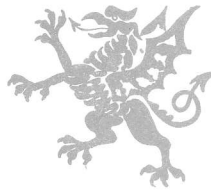

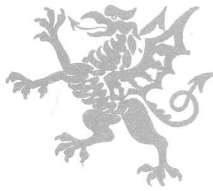

Committee I am pleased to enclose our Financial Report,
which shows a final credit balance of US\$3804.57.

In accordance with the Rules and Regulations to
Sponsoring Organisations of National Gymanfaoedd, which
you supplied to our Committee, and which refers to a
resolution at the 1958 Annual Meeting of the Association,
I am enclosing a check for US\$2,282.74, which sum represents
60% of the credit balance.

At the Quarterly meeting of the St. David's Society of
the State of New York, which took place last night, it
was agreed that the sum of \$250 be donated to the WNGGA
from the 40% authorised for retention by the Sponsoring
Organisation. This amount was voted to compensate for
non-use of the WNGGA hymnal and consequent lack of
opportunity for local sales.

The two checks will close out all bank accounts.

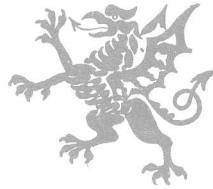

My Committee has much pleasure in forwarding a provisional Financial Report of the 1975 Gymanfa held in the New York Hilton. A copy is being sent to Mr. Gwynn Parri and Mr. Jack Meadows. I am sorry this could not be forwarded earlier but as you will note monies are still coming in and \$460 is still outstanding from the program receivables. The Hoover Co., Ottawa Welsh Society, London Welsh Society and SCM Corporation all placed \$100 ads but it is expected that Dr. Islyn Thomas can finalise these delinquents shortly. The WNGGA Endowment Fund has a \$60 item outstanding.

As far as can be determined, we await a few small bills for manila envelopes and programs from our printer - and also a small item for bank charges. The sum of \$100 should allow us to clear our desks of all outstanding items, including those already mentioned.

The cost of the 48 red roses used for the WNGGA Memorial Service ceremony (\$120) is included in the "Church Service" expenses. We questioned the florist about this expense but apparently long-stemmed red roses are this expensive.
