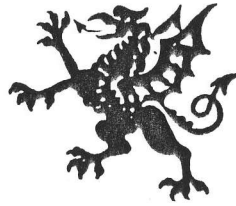

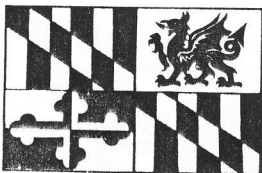
As you indicated in our phone conversation, you would be presenting the matter to you committee very soon. Please keep me advised of your action and feeling.

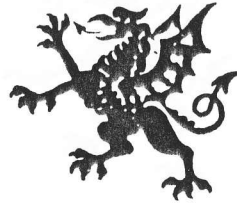

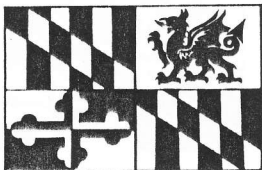
