Rising to prominence through RuPaul's Drag Race UK, Tayce became one of the most visible Welsh drag artists representing Wales on mainstream television.

Through drag, fashion, modelling and media, she broadened how Wales is seen; centring Black, queer visibility with confidence and authenticity.
