*Nos 16 to 30 are grade II listed for their group value. All were originally Came properties, leased or conveyed by Richard Franklen of Clemenstone in 1830 – 40*

1841 Lease, Richard Franklen of Clemenstone to Thos.Lewis, gardener, of Cowbridge - the piece of land between 20 and 30 High Street with covenant that he built 3 houses on the plot within 6 months.
