23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> July 1746

Assignment and redemption of mortgage (by lease and release with counterpart release) for £420 to Anne Howard and £70 to Evan Jenkins.

Anne Howard of Llysworney spinster, by appointment of Evan Jenkins of Rudry gent., to James Morgan of Cowbridge mercer, to the use of Nathaniel Taynton of Cowbridge gent. And Thomas Edmondes of Cowbridge gent.

Close or field (4 acres) called the Stumpy Four Acres in occupation of Stephen Skinner, exciseman; closes (4 acres) called the stumpy lower two acres and the stumpy upper two acres in occupation of Philip Walton clockmaker; close or field called the stumpy three-quarters acre or three quarters, y carreg gwyn and a small parcel of land (one burgage) in occupation of John Carne surgeon, all adjoining messuages leading east from the river and bridge of Cowbridge, and adjoining south and east the highway called the Broadway.
