Church. It I give to ye poor of ye parish of Lanharan p<sup>se</sup> It I give  
to my Cousen Elizabeth Thomas of Lanharan widow p<sup>se</sup> It I give  
to Mr Edward Davies late vicar of Lanblethian p<sup>se</sup> It I give to  
Anne Kemys y<sup>e</sup> supposed daughter of Sr Nicholas Kemys p<sup>se</sup> It I  
give to Jennet my maid-servant p<sup>se</sup> It I give & devise my house, Barn  
the garden with the appurtenances in Cowbridge aforesaid, to John  
Williams my son, beinge now of Oriell Coll in Oxon. to have & to hold  
ye premises with the appurtenances unto my said son John Williams, &  
to the heirs of his body lawfully to be begotten, and for want of such  
heirs to Mary Watkins & Margaret Watkins daughters of my sister  
Elizabeth Jones & their heirs for ever, And as for ye disposall of  
my household stuff and implements of household, I give & bequeath the  
same to my said son John Williams, provided, that maide my wife shall  
have & enjoy ye use thereof duringe hie widowye, except one bed-steed, one  
woolwed rug, feather bed, Bolster & appurtenances to ye same belonginge  
in ye chamber where I usually lay in my house, the drawing-table, two  
great brass kettles or Caldrons, & one great brass boyling-pot, ye rest of  
my goods cattle & chattle whersoever I give & bequeath unto my said  
son John Williams, whom I doe hereby make, ordaine, & appoint to be  
sole Executo<sup>r</sup> of this my last will & Testament; and I doe by these presents  
revoke all former wills, in witness whereof I have hereunto put  
my hand & seale ye seventh day of April in ye year of o<sup>r</sup> Lord God
