

The will of Henry George of Cowbridge dated 24th., July 1654.

To the Cathedral at Llandaff 6d.

To his nephew Christopher Jenkin, the house and garden in garden with the deeds and the papers showing the interest of John Robert in the property.

To the seven children of Christopher Bassett of Llanblethian £7 to be shared out equally, the eldest daughter excepted.

To Ann, Cecil, Friswith and Alice Bassett, daughters of Christopher, four kine to be equally divided between them, two of the kine being in the hands of Howell Evan of Penllyn and two in the hands of Thomas Prichard of Llanmihangel.

To Mary Thomas the daughter of Edward Thomas of Llanblethian, a cow in the hands of Thomas Prichard to be delivered in the May after his demise.

To the three children of his nephew John Rees of Cowbridge, three kine and 20 sheep to be divided equally amongst them, two of the kine at St. Mary Church and the other at Pendoylan. and £6 between them.

To the two children of John Robert of Cowbridge, two kine being in Penllyn, and 16 sheep fully woolled and £2 between them.

To his nephew William Robert £5 now in the hands of George Clement

The rest of his goods to Christopher Jenkin, John Robert and Margaret Jenkin wife of John Rees as executors.
