

The will of Florence Wilcock of Cowbridge dated 15th., May 1665.

The messuage, garden and orchard containing one messuage, outside the west gate at Cowbridge lately purchased by her father James Wilcock, to her kinswomen Jane and Elizabeth Bassett the daughters of the late Sir Richard Bassett.

The rest of her goods to Jane and Elizabeth Bassett as joint executrixes.

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Wilcock of Leobridge  
in the County of Glamorgan and Diocese of Llandaff such of  
body but of perfect remembrance law and grace - be to Almighty  
God doe make and ordain this my last will and Testament  
in manner and forme following, First I commend my soule  
into the hands of Almighty God my maker hoping through  
the meritty death and passion of Jesus Christ my Lord  
and Saviour to have forgiveness of Sinnes and life of  
Eternall and my body to be Interred in Christian Buriall  
Looking and making Null and void all former and  
other will and wills by me at any time heretofore made  
and this alone to be my last will and Testament. Item I give  
and devise all that Messuage Garden Orchard together withall  
and Singular its rights members and appurtenances situate  
lying and being without the Walls Gates of the Town of Leobridge - afore-  
said in the said County Cont. one Burgage lately bought and  
purchased by my late father James Wilcock deceased unto my  
deare and loving kinneswomen wives. Jane Bassett and Mrs Elizabeth  
Bassett late daughters to Sir. Richard Bassett knight deceased  
to have and to hold the said Messuage Garden and Orchard with  
its appurtenances to the said Mrs. Jane Bassett and Mrs. Elizabeth  
Bassett their heirs and assigns for ever. Item I give unto  
beneath all the rest of my goods hables shabbles and house hold  
stuff unto the said Mrs Jane Bassett and Mrs Elizabeth Bassett  
unto whom I do nominate and appoint to be Joynt Executors of this  
my last will and Testament. In Witnes whereof I have hereunto put  
my hand and seal the fiftenth day of May Chemo 1644 Idid mei  
Caroli seruus non clug or do meo de ptimo clm o g di m 1644
