

The will of David Powell of Cowbridge, gent, dated 9th., December 1670.

To his cousin William Thomas of Colwinston, 2 acres and one other in Llangan, one called Cutt Acre and the other lying to the west side of a close called Blackland in agreement with Mrs. Mary Thomas of Cowbridge and Denice Thomas of Penlline, spinster.

All the rest of his goods to his wife Isabella Powell as executrix.

of Towbridge do hereby make my last will and Testament
in manner & form followinge That is to say first I give &
bequeath my soule unto Allmightie God my Maker & Redeemer
by whose merits I hope to be saved & my body to be buried in
Christian burill. Itt I give & devise to my deere daughter
Thomas of Colchester in the said County two Acres of
land lying & being in the parish of Langan in the said County
one acre & two thirds commonly called and known by the name
the Butt acre & the other three fourths on the west side of
one the late called the blackland & have I to hold the said
two acres with its appurtenances unto the said William
Thomas his heirs and assigns for ever for & towards his
service & saving harmless from such engagem^{ts} as he is
engaged for me to make. Mary Thomas of the Towne of Towbridge
I do Devise & give of the parish of Dullin in the said
County of Linc^{ns} my deere wife Isabella Powell to be my sole executrix
of all my goods chattels and chattels as well moveable as
immovable after my debts be paid & my funerall expenses
discharged In witness whereof I have hereunto set
