possession of y^e said Winifrida Waltham or into y^e hands & possession
of any other person or persons for her doe make & truly answer according to law & further doe make
or cause to be made a true & just account of her vsd. Account at or before y^e 7th day of October
Ann[us] D[omi]ni 1702. And all y^e rest & residue of y^e said Goods, Chattels & Credits which shall be found
