

The will of Janet Thomas of Cowbridge dated 1st., December 1707.

All debts and funeral expenses to be paid Rice Nicholl, as executor.

To Elizabeth Thomas, her daughter and wife to Rice Nicholl, 50s.

To her grandchild Mary Howell, daughter of Elizabeth Thomas by her first husband Nicholas Howell, 50s.

To Margaret John daughter of John Early, £3.

The house leased under three lives - Janet Thomas, Margaret John and Mary Howells to Margaret John. If she marries then half the contents to pass to Mary Howell, who would inherit the house on the death of Margaret John.

All moneys to Rice Nicholl.

To be buried in the grave of her daughter in Llanblethian Church.

A vat, 2 tubs, a brass pan and a dish to Margaret John

To Mary Howell the furnace in Llanblethian, a cupboard, a chest, and other furniture.

In the Name of God amen. I John Thomas of 4<sup>e</sup> soneth  
of 50<sup>e</sup> yeare of age, in the County of Glamorgan being at present  
sick in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blanke to  
God deo make and ordaine this my present last will and testament  
In manner following first and principally I command my soul to  
the hand of God Almighty departing this life my spirit shall to passion  
of my saundit. It sayeth to have fide and firt hertes and desirous  
of all my sinnes and to inherit everlasting life; and my body I do desire  
to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter named  
and touching my disposition of all such temporal Estate or goods  
as it shall pleased god almighty to bestow on me I give and  
dispose as followeth

first. I will that my debts and funerall Charge shall be payd  
discharged by Alice Nicholls my present executors  
Item. I give to Elizabeth Thomas my daughter wife to Ricke Nicholls  
the summe of fifty shillings and to her daughter Mary Howell daughter  
to her first husband Nicholas Howell ex summe of fifty shilling. And to  
Margaret John q. daughter of John Early ex summe of 3 pounds  
Item. The house wherein I did dwelle being purchased by lease from John in  
During my life Margaret John and Mary Howell shall have the leasehold and  
mytmes in said house during her life so theye lead a single life  
generall with in said house during her life so theye lead a single life  
but if she marry haue y<sup>e</sup> good alij. tyme & to equalle to y<sup>e</sup> said Mary Howell  
and when y<sup>e</sup> said Margaret John is deceasid & to equalle her house and all the  
goods in the same to y<sup>e</sup> said Mary Howell so y<sup>e</sup> said Margaret John dyeth  
without issue otherwise y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid halfe of y<sup>e</sup> stuffe fully to her issue the money  
due to me from y<sup>e</sup> following particulars & to equalle to my executors Ricke Nicholls  
and his wife pindarly. And I desire to be buryed in grave  
near by the chappel of Saint Thomas Gallored  
sealed my memory ab. a date 2 hundreth brasse plate, and y<sup>e</sup> day of this y<sup>e</sup>  
equalle to Margaret John and a go<sup>e</sup> tare of y<sup>e</sup> Margaret John & also equalle  
to Mary Howell, y<sup>e</sup> tare in Saint Thomas, one large pinte, one custard and one  
eggs two tare. In case Ricke Nicholls shal die before his wife and marry another  
otherwise to haue the managm. till he dye and then theye fall to Mary Howell  
or her heirs. In witness whereof I y<sup>e</sup> signe & Thomas to help my last  
will & testament do set my hand and seale, y<sup>e</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> day of December in  
y<sup>e</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> year of y<sup>e</sup> reigne of our souveraine King Edward, and in y<sup>e</sup> year of our  
Lord god 1409.
