 hands or possession of the said Guillelmu[m] William or into the hands and
 possession of any other person or persons for h[is] doth well and truly administer
 according to law And further doth make or cause to be made a true and just account
 of h[is] Administration at or before y^e 25^o day of September next
 and all the rest and residue of the said goods chattels and credits which shall be found
 remaining upon the said Administrator's account the same being first examined and
 allowed of by the Judge or Judges for the time being of the said Court shall deliver
 and pay unto such person or persons respectively, as the said Judge or Judges, by his
 or their decree or sentence so made to the true intent and meaning of a late Act of
 Parliament made in the two and twentieth and third and twentieth years of the reign
 of o[ur] late Sovereign King Charles the second (Intituled An Act for the better
 settling of Intestates Estates) shall limit and appoint And if it shall hereafter
