The barns in Llancarfan to be left to his wife subject to her paying his debts.

All the rest of his goods to his wife as executrix.

Signed by John Carne

Witnessed by John Lewis, Evan Morgan and Christopher Williams.

Proved 6th October 1719.

 County of Gloucestre gent being sick in body but of perfect memory
 thanks be to God I do make this my last will and Testament in
 manner and form following First I commend my soul unto the
 Almighty God that gave it me Resigning the glorious Death
 portion of my only Saviour Jesus Christ to obtain full pardon of all
 my sins and my Body to be decently buried by my Country here
 after named, Item I give devise and bequeth unto my
 well beloved wife Anne Tames all my lands and Tenements
 during her life upon condition that she shall pay my Body
 Item I give devise and bequeth unto her my said wife
 Anne Tames the Barne of Lanarvan upon condition that she
 will pay all my debts Lastly all other my goods both Chatter
 moveable and unmoveable here is not bequethed I give and
 bequeth to my well beloved wife whom I do hereby
 nominate and appoint sole Executrix of this my last will and
 Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand
 and seal the sixteenth day of April Anno Regni Domini
 Caroly non Regis Magnae Britanniae et quinq; anno
 Domini 1719
