

In the name of God, Amen, I Mary Mott of the Town of Cwbridge  
in the County of Glamorgan widow, being grown in years, but  
of sound, and perfect memory (praised be God) Do hereby make,  
constitute, and declare this my last will, and testament in manner  
following, (viz) First I recommend my soul to God, who gave it me, and  
my body to the earth, from whence it came; And as for my Mofuages,  
lands, tenements, and hereditaments and all and singular my goods  
cattles and chattels Real and personal, I give and dispose thereof  
as followeth (viz) In primis I give unto my two Grand daughters, Mary  
Cornish, and Anne Cornish Six hundred pounds, to be equally divided  
and paid between them both; Ilt I give unto my said Grand daughters  
Six Feather bed and the bed cloths to them belonging; Ilt I give and  
bequeath unto my said Grand daughters My House by the East end of  
the bridge in Cwbridge aforesaid with the appurtenances to hold  
to them and their heirs forever. Ilt I give unto Mary John Fifty  
Shillings; and to David John Fifty Shillings; and to Elizabeth David  
Fifty Shillings and to Annmarie Rodriguez fifty Shillings; And  
to Mr Richard Bales son Fifty Shillings; All of the Town of  
Cwbridge aforesaid: Ilt I give unto my kinsman Mr John Yorke  
Jen. of Danwell Major Two pounds; And to John Dore his son  
Fifty Shillings; Ilt I give unto my maid servant Kathrine William  
Two pounds, if she lives in my service at the time of my death; Ilt  
I give unto my Nephew Richard Robert five pounds, to be paid him  
yearly during his life by my Executor herein hereafter named  
And all and singular the rest and residue of my said Mofuages, lands  
tenements and hereditaments, and all and singular my said goods  
cattles, and chattels Real and personal whatsoever, I give, devise  
and bequeath the same unto my Grand son Pieres Cornish, who  
I Do hereby make, Nominal, and appoint to be the only Executor  
of this my last will, and testament. At witness whereof, I have

Domini 1727
