bequeath in manner and form following first
I will and bequeath to Margaret Jones my nephew one shilling
I give and bequeath to my neece Mary Day wife of William
Dean the sum of forty pounds one silver tankard one silver
tumbler three silver spoons my best bed that I use to lye on
with all its appurtenances all my wearing apparrell (except those
beare after named and excepted) the best case of drawers and
one brass pan I will that all the money due to me from
Mrs Joan Thomas of Cardiffe widow be discharged and acquitted
giving her the same as a legacy I give and bequeath
to my coler Cathorine Nichol now living at Ewenny the sum
of ten pounds I give and bequeath to Mrs Mary Malher
wife of Mr Humphrey Malher the sum of two hundred I give
and bequeath to Ann Swan of Lanmaw my old maid servant
all the goods and things that I left with her and is now in her
keeping I give and bequeath to Mrs Mary Pharo widow
one hundred I give and bequeath to Richard Buley the
elder the sum of two hundred I give to the poor of this
towne of Cowbridge twenty shillings and the like sum of twenty
shillings to the poor of Lantwit major And lastly I do hereby
nominate declare and appoint my beloved & true woman Mrs
Margaret Newgood to be my sole executrix and residuary
legatee of this my last will and testament hereby revoking
and annulling all former wills by me made as witness my
hand and seal this twenty ninth day of March in the
year of our Lord god 1732
