

Know all Men by these presents that We Mary Thomas of the County of Cambridge in the County of Cambridge Gentlewoman and Nathaniel Dayton of the County of Cambridge Gentleman are become bound unto the most honored father in God John Lord Archbishop of Canterbury in the sum of One hundred pound pounds of good and lawfull money of great Brittain to be paid unto him the said Lord Archbishop or his lawfull Attorney his Executors Administrators Successors or Assigns for the good and faithfull payment of which summe well and truly to be made. We bind our selves and each of us jointly and severally for the whole cure Exors Executors and Administrators & finally by these presents sealed with our Seals and dated the third day of October in the year of our Lord Christ 1738

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bounden Mary Thomas the natural and lawfull Heir and Administratrix of all & singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of Anne Thomas late of the County of Cambridge deceased

do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Mary Thomas or into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for her - And the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the Consistory Court of Lindsse at or before the day of December next ensuing and the same Goods Chattels and Credits and all other the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased at the time of her death or which at any time after shall come to the hands or possession of the said

Mary Thomas or person or persons for her do well and truly administer according to Law find in the do make or cause to be made a true and just account of her said Administration at or before the third day of October in the year of our Lord 1739

and all the rest and residue of the said Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Administration her account the same being first examined and allowed of by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as the said Judge by his decree or sentence pursuant to the true intent and meaning of an Act of Parliament Intituled an Act for the better settling of Intestates Estates shall direct and appoint and if hereafter it shall appear any Error or mistake was made by the said deceased and the Executors or Administrators named do exhibit the same into the said Court making request to have it approved or

accordingly if the said Mary Thomas do render and deliver the said Letters of Administration or such Testament come first read and made into the said Court then this obligation to be void or else to remain in full force
