

Know all men by these presents that We Elizabeth Ballard of the Town of Cowbridge in the County of Glamorgan Widow and Edward Ballard of the same place Skinner and Richard Williams of the Parish of Lambeth in the County aforesaid Horsecourer —  
 by became bound unto the Right Rev. Father in God Richard by divine permission Lord Bishop of Landaff in the sum of two hundred — pounds of good and lawfull Money of Great Britain to be paid to the said Lord Bishop or his lawfull Assigns or Assigns for the good and faithful payments of which sum We and truly to be made We bind our selves and each of us jointly and severally for the whole our said Exors and admrs jointly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the fifth — day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety —



The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above bounden Elizabeth Ballard do the said and administratrix of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of Edward Ballard late of the Town of Cowbridge in the County of Glamorgan and Diocese of Landaff deceased —

do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deed which have or shall come to the Hands possession or Knowledge of the said Elizabeth Ballard — or into the Hands possession or Knowledge of any other person or persons for her and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the Consistory Court of Landaff on or before the last day of November next ensuing and the same Goods Chattels and Credits and all other the Goods Chattels & Credits of the said Deed which at the time of his death or which at any time hereafter shall come to the Hands possession of the said Elizabeth Ballard — or into the Hands possession of any other person or persons for her do well and truly Administer According to Law and Justice do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Account of her said Administration on or before the last day of August — which will be in the year 1791 and all the rest & residue of the said Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining on the said Administration Account the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as the said Judge by his decree or sentence pursuant to the true intent & meaning of an Act of Parliament intitled an Act for the better settling Intestate Estates / shall limit and appoint and if hereafter it shall appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the said Deed and the Exors or Exors then named do exhibit the same into the said Court making request to have the same approved of accordingly if the said Elizabeth Ballard — being then and lawfully required do render and deliver the said debts of Administration of the said Deed being first had and made into the said Court the said obligation to be void and of no effect or else to remain in full force and Virtue
