

The will of Watkin Evan of Llanblethian made 4<sup>th</sup> March 1729.

To his cousin Ellinor of the parish of Llangynwyd, 1s.

To the eldest child of his cousin Wenllian lately deceased, 1s.

All the rest of his goods to his wife Cecil Evan also Watkin as executrix.

The mark of Watkin Evan.

Proved 28<sup>th</sup> October 1729.

In the name of God Amen I William Evan of the parish of  
 Llanblethian in the County of Glamorgan and Diocese of Llandaff being sick and weak in  
 body but of sound and perfect memory thank be given to God Almighty for the same do  
 hereby make Constitutions and ordain that my last Will and Testament in form and manner  
 following is.

I give and bequeath unto my loving Son John Evan of the parish of Llanblethian  
 the sum of one Shilling of current Brittain money.

Item I give and dispose unto my ~~loving Son~~ the Elder Child of my  
 loving Son William Evan lately deceased the sum of one Shilling of the current money.

Item and lastly I give bequeath and dispose unto my dear beloved & true wife Sarah  
 Evan wd. William all the rest and residue of my Goods Liable and Things as well moveable  
 as immoveable as well to them as without Controul and personal knowlege and  
 assent and appoint to be a sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament,

Reserving and Reserving all other Wills and Testaments by me formerly made or to be  
 either by word or writing: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
 seal this the fourth day of March Anno Domini 1728
