

The will of Mary Cole, spinster of Llanblethian, dated 30th., October 1748.

To her niece Mary Cole all her goods, ready money and effects.

To he nephew John Cole brother to Mary Cole 5s. to be paid within three months of death.

To Margaret David daughter of John and Catherine David 5s.

To Anne Lougher daughter of Robert and Margaret Lougher 5s.

Her niece Mary Cole to be executrix.

Proved 14th., November 1748.

In the name of God Amen Mary-
Cole Abb. of the. of Lambethian being of sound mind memory
and understanding, praised be God, although weak in body
And considering that a certain appointed to die, Do therefore make
Deeds and Appoint this to be my Right Last will and Testament
in manner and form following, That I do hereby, I will, recommend
my soul to God that gave it In hopes of a Joyfull resurrection
at which I shall be leftward: as for such worldly goods as I
do possess I desire God to know me without at the time of
Decease I desire of the same in manner and form following
I will bequeath and bequeath unto my Dear
and Loving Sister Mary Cole Abb. that Goods, ready money
or other effects any kind of botany or Appurtenances that I
shall be possessed of at any time hereafter, And the said Mary
shall pay and discharge my funeral expenses and all other
my debts due as I shall be bound at the time of my Decease, Item
I will bequeath unto my Nephew John Cole Brother to my Sister
the sum of five shillings to be paid him within three months after
my Decease, And further I do hereby give to my Nephew
John Cole that one Shilling what he shall see or who may be assigned
unto me whether by Bond Note of Hand or any other manner
whatsoever I give the same unto my said Niece Mary Cole the
sum I give to Mary Daughter of John Cole the sum of five
shillings I give to Mary Long's daughter
of Robt. Mary Long's the sum of five shillings to be paid them
within three months after my Decease by my Executors having
the directions And lastly I do hereby Appoint my said
Niece Mary Cole to be my sole and true Executor of this my
last will and Testament, Hereby revoking and Disallowing
any other or former wills papers or Deeds of Gifts whatsoever
by me at any time made or Done, All witness whereof
the said Mary Cole has subscribed set my Hand and Seal
this 30. Day of October in the year of our Lord 1748.
