 Esqrs. Gentlemen

are become bound unto y^e Right Hon^{ble} Father in God Edward by divine permission Archbishop of
 Landaff, in y^e sum of Five Hundred pound of good & lawfull Moneys of Great Brittain, to be paid
 unto y^e said Archbishop or his lawfull attorney his Ex^{ty} adm^r. These presents or Assigns for good and
 faithfull paym^{ts}. of y^e sum well & truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us severally and
 severally for y^e whole, our Heirs, Ex^{ty} adm^r firmly by these presents sealed with our seals
 and dated the 6th Day of August, in the Year of our Lord 1700.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bounden William Miles
 the brother and administrator of all and singular y^e goods, Chattels and Credits of
 Elizabeth Holland late of y^e parish of Llanblethian, in the County of Glamorgan
 Widow of Llantrisant widow Deceased, to the use and enjoyment of y^e said Elizabeth a
 minor, the natural and lawfull son of y^e said Elizabeth
 do make or cause to be made, a true & perfect Inventory of all y^e singular y^e goods, Chattels, Credits, &c.
 w^{ch} have or shall come to y^e hand, possession or knowledge of y^e said William Miles
 or into y^e hand & possession of any other person or persons for him and y^e same is made do exhibit or
 cause to be exhibited into y^e Registry of Consistory Court of Landaff, at or before the next
 Day of ~~the next~~ next anniversary, and y^e same goods, Chattels, Credits, and all other y^e goods, Chattels
 and Credits of y^e said Elizabeth, at y^e time of her Death, or w^{ch} at any time after shall come to y^e hand
 and possession of y^e said William Miles or into y^e hand and possession
 of any other person or persons for him do well and truly administer according to law and
 further do make or cause to be made, a true & perfect Invent^y of his said assets, at or before the
 sixth Day of August next w^{ch} will be in y^e Year 1701 and all y^e rest and
 residue of y^e said goods, Chattels, Credits w^{ch} shall be found remaining upon y^e said
 administrator's account the same being first examined and allowed of by y^e Judge
 of said Court for y^e time being shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons
 respectively as y^e said Judge by his Decree or sentence pursuant to y^e true intent and
 meaning of an Act of Parliament intituled an Act for y^e better settling of y^e Succession
 Estates shall limit and appoint y^e said y^e said Act shall appear on y^e Statute and
 Testaments was made by y^e said Deceased, and y^e said or her Heirs or Assigns do exhibit
 the same into y^e said Court, making request to have it approved of accordingly
 the said William Miles being thereunto lawfully required
 do render and deliver y^e said Invent^y of admⁿ of approbation of y^e said Court
 being first had and made into y^e said Court, then this Obligation to be void
 and of no effect or else to remain in full force and Virtue.
