

The will of Mary Richard of Llanblethian dated 29th August 1771.

To Mary Jones one shilling.

To Catherine Giddings one shilling.

To the children of John David by Mary^{over}, his wife, one shilling each.

To the children of David Thomas by Jane, his wife, one shilling each.

To the poor of the parish of Llanblethian one guinea.

To Anne, the wife of Richard Matthew ten shillings and sixpence.

To Elizabeth, the wife of David Williams her house near the castle at Llanblethian.

The rest of the estate to Elizabeth Williams as executrix.

The mark of Mary Richards.

Proved – 15th August 1776.

In the Name of God Amen I Richard
do make Ordain constitute and appoint
this to be my last Will and Testament in
Manner and form following. That is to say
First I commit my Soul into the Hands
of Almighty God, and my Body to the
Earth there to be buried in a decent Christian
like manner, and as for my worldly Effects
I give and bequeath in the manner following.
I give and bequeath to Mary Jones the Sum
of one Shilling. I give and bequeath to Jak-
erine Tiddings the Sum of one Shilling.
I give and bequeath to the Children of John
David by Margaret his Wife the Sum of
one Shilling each. I give and bequeath
to the Children of David Thomas by Jane
his Wife the Sum of one Shilling each.
I give and bequeath to the Poor of the
Parish of Lambeth one Guinea to be
divided amongst them. I give and bequeath
to Anne the Wife of Richard Mattheis the
Sum of Ten Shillings and six pence. I give
and bequeath to Elizabeth the Wife of
David Williams my dwelling House
situated being and being near the Parke
of Lambeth to Her and her Heirs for
ever. Lastly I give and bequeath unto the
said Elizabeth Williams all and singular
my Goods Chattels personal Estate and all
and singular my Securities Bonds Notes
that I am already possessed of, appointing
Her the said Elizabeth Williams my

whole and sole executrix of this my last Will
and Testament and I do hereby revoke and
make void all former and other Will or Wills
by me heretofore made constituting and ap-
pointing this to be my last Will and Testament.
In Witness whereof I the Testatrix have hereunto
set my hand and seal this Twenty Ninth Day
of August in the Seventh year of the Reign
of our Sovereign Lord King George the Third,
and in the year of our Lord God one Thousand
Seven hundred Twenty and one.
