In the name of God of men of Edward Grant of Lisworney in the county of
glancorgan Gent: being praised be Almighty God (though sick in body)
yet sound and perfect in minde and memory do make and declare this
to be my last will and testament and do here by revoke disannul and
make void all former wills and testaments by me heretofore made. Decla-
ring this to be my last, in manner and forme following (that is to say)
first and principally I commend my soule into the hands of Almighty
God hoping through the merit death and passion of my Saviour
Jesus christ to have full and free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins
and to inherit ever lasting life: and my body I commit to the earth
to be decently buried in the parish church of Lisworney, and as touch-
ing the disposition of all my estate both real and personall as it hath
pleased almighty God to bestow upon me I give and dispose thereof
as followeth. first I will that my debts and funeral charges shall be
paid and discharged by my executrix here after
named allowing eight pound charge towards my burial. Item I give
and bequeath to the Cathedral church of Landaff two shillings.
Item I give and bequeath all my free hold land to my well beloved
nephew Christopher Grant and his heirs for ever but the seven
acres commonly knowne by the name of faith erro heule hunt I give
for one year after my death to my well beloved niece twentilian
williams of Lisworney spinster and after the 3^d yeare to the 3^d
Christopher Grant and his heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath
to my well beloved niece Margaret the wife of Edward Prichard
of the parish of Sanmase, clerk twenty pound of currant English
money to be paid by my executrix within a yeare after my
death. Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved niece Cissill
Grant of Lisworney spinster twenty pound of currant English
money, a feather bed and pillowber two blankets and a coverlet all
to be paid and delivered by my executrix within one yeare after my
death. Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved nephew William
Thomas of Sanmase lab^r: ten sheep. Item I give and bequeath to my
well beloved niece Jane othomas spinster sister to the 3^d William
othomas ten sheep. Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved
nephew James Grant marriner fifty shillings to be paid within one
yeare by my Executrix if he happen within the yeare or any time

time after to come into the countrey. Item I give to
Joan the wife of John Thomas of Liffworney Lab^r twenty shillings
Item I give and bequeath to the poore of Liffworney twenty shillings
Item I give and bequeath towards repairing the church of Liffworney
tenn shillings. Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved niece
wenllian william of Liffworney spinster all the rest and residue of
my personall estate goods and Chattle what so ever and I do name and
appoint her the D^o wenllian williane my full and sole Executrix
of this my last will and testament in witness whereunto I set my
hand seale the twelfth day of March an: Dom: 1687
