Llantrithyd Place

Three Wells in the Wood Coed Arthur opposite on the hill gravity feed the old place with water. These Wells built like and Iglo or Welsh Pig Sty, IE (St Fagans)

Two reasons for this, one to keep water clean, two to hang venison or game birds etc. cool store. Only one well 75% intact; the other two needs repairs. I have reported this to the powers that be, but no action taken by (M.A.). There's only one set of Wells in England of this type that's two in the UK. The Wells are now on private ground.

Once owned by Radcliffe Estate purchased by the Forestry Commission now back in private hands the (AG TRUST) the FC. Sold small units back to the public.

Llantrithyd Church

In the 1920-30 Lord Glan Ely made a donation of a Petrol generator so Electricity from Rectory was placed in the church. It seems he was related to the Vicar of the day Rev. Banks Williams. Mains electric did not come to the village til 1948. It was installed in Rectory, but not in the church. Reason, the old type cloth insulation was not safe, they never resolved the problem and in 2004 we still have no electric.

My relation Katherine Berrow passed away May 2004. Her wish her ashes placed in the padock by the house. I asked permission for a small plaque to be placed in Church Porch on wall outside approx 6"x3"post card size. Answer no from Bishops Office but if I was to repair bell etc. Then a memorial plaque could be placed in the church. (B.M) This out of my reach, I made an offer to install Electric to the building and it was up to them, about inside heat & light etc. I had an admin back in return. Section stated it can take six years to grant permission. So I said I will discontinue any more administration, and forget the offer. Their loss.

I have now placed a plaque on padock wall. This lady was a member of the church, but lost her way the last year of life.

Little more data

A lady's headstone near to the Church Porch the <u>mother of 36 children</u>. In 1930 the Vicar Tom Price thought it immoral. he decided to take a chisel and remove the six and leave the three. This upset the natives, he had to reinstate the number six which still stands today.

One was blind. he could cut a hedge by hand better than a lot of farmers who had good eyesight. He would say to my uncle, how am I for straight?, he would run his hand over the top. Later farmed by the Fairfax family who remain there today.

Another gentleman had a chain drawn pocket watch, that was something for a young lad, myself, to see.
