Government Evacuation  
Scheme.

The latest news is that upwards of 200 persons, including mothers and children from the London District, are to arrive here on Sunday next. Meanwhile, persons who have privately evacuated themselves continue to arrive daily - upwards of 400 have already been dealt with. I have with me in the office the wife of an airman from St Athan (from Kent) who has applied for herself and two children (a boy age 8 and a girl age 3) to be billeted. Unless they get accommodation by tomorrow they will have to return to Kent. I, therefore, have to ask you to receive these three people and I shall be much obliged if you will arrange to receive them tomorrow (Thursday) afternoon.
