1608/9 Covenant to levy a fine...of a messuage and one barn in Cowbridge between the house of George Pranche on the east and the town wall on the north, refernce to two crofts, one of which has the place called the Brode Shoard on the west part

Talbot deeds 721

1778 Reference to a garden, formerly occupied by Elizabeth Jones then of John Edwards, adjacent east the house and garden of John Llewellyn, west the broad shoar, south the turnpike road, north the town walls

D/Ed 153

(recites a lease in 1776 by Charles Wyndham to John Edmondes)

Ruinous cottage in the occupation of John Thomas, labourer, adjacent to the east the pine end of his dwelling house and the waste ground adjoining known as Broad George or Broad Shord, having the dwelling house and garden of John Thomas on the west, lands of Charles Edwin (Wyndhams of Dunraven) on the north, the garden of Charles Edwin in the occupation of Robert Arnot, gardener on the east, and the highway on the south – lease to Mr John Thomas of Cowbridge, gent.
