

Caia'r Lloi (Broadway-opposite Great House), Llanblethian

- 1781 Admission of Revd. T. Bruce (son and heir of William Bruce) on surrender of Thomas Thomas of Lambeth (grandson and heir of John Thomas of Llanblethian, tailor deceased who was feoffee in trust for William Bruce of Llanblethian) – messuage and lands, formerly purchased by Cann Wilkins from Mary Llewellyn, widow,
lands called the Crofta Mawr (15 acres), the Windmill Cross (4 acres), Kaer Lloy and Gwain Kaer lloy (6 acres) and various other small parcels (total 33 and a quarter acres),
and also a dwelling house and various parcels, all in Llanblethian (Windmill Lane area) *D/D Bruce 69*
- 1805 Surrender of Thomas and Eleanor Markham to the use of Anthony Williams gent. *1516, p 155*
- 1815 Will of Anthony Williams to his daughter Mary Williams.
- 1817 Mary Williams to Edward David of Radyr
- 1819 Mary David died – her son became Revd. Edward David
- 1839 Revd Edward David mortgaged the land –
four parcels, about 14 acres, *p 158*
20 acres, formerly in the tenure of Rees Adam (of Stallcourt), undertenant of Evan Lewis, and afterwards of Evan Thomas, thatcher, now Thomas Jones.
- 1849 Surrendered
- 1906 Re-grant of premises to Reginald Frederick David of Llanfair farmer *106/7*
- 1913 Thomas Thomas formerly of Red Farm, Penllyn, now of Stallcourt, admitted tenant. *1519, p 284*
- 1918 Surrender to Owen Williams of Crossways – 607, 608, 609 and 610 on the OS map of 1899 *284*
- Owen Williams sold :
- 1923 field 607 (part) to Vivian S. Gwyn of Broadway Villa *63*
- 1925 field (part) *81*
- 1925 15 acres of Caerlloi 608,609,610 to Glyn Morgan Thomas of Stallcourt, farmer *85*
