

Sir John Nicholl

Born 16/3/1739, second son of John Nicholl of Llanmaes and wife Elizabeth Havard. Early schooling at Cowbridge Grammar School, and Bristol. Fellow of St John's College 1775.

MP 1802-33 for Penryn (1802), Hastings (1806), Great Bedwin (1807-32).

King's Advocate – general 1798 and knighted.

Judge of the Prerogative Court of Canterbury.

Dean of the Arches 1809-34.

Judge of the High Court of Admiralty 1833-38.

Died 1838.

1787 married Judy Birt, youngest daughter of Peter Birt of Wenvoe Castle.

They had five children (one died in infancy).

Bought the Merthyr Mawr estate in 1804, engaging Henry Wood of London and Bristol as architect for the house (completed 1810).

Illtyd Nichol 1743-87.

Son of John Nichol of Llanmaes.

Matriculated Jesus College, Oxford 1756.

Fellow 1765-80.

John Nichol 1743-1830.

Son of Whitlock Nichol of the Ham, Llantwit Major.

Rector of ? Revesham.

Married Mary Flower, daughter of Henry, first Lord Ashbrook.
