Report to the Council.

The Sub Committee appointed to make arrangements for the Billeting of the Horses of the Glamorgan Yeomanry has to report as follows:-

On Monday, Feby. 25th they met Major Pritchard & arranged to have a Shed built in the Cattle Market in lieu of taking up the Pens in the Pig Market.

The Cost of the work was £75.9.4.

The great increase in the Cost of Timber is the reason of the high figure.

Towards this amount the Council will receive 3d. per horse per night for 70 horses which amounts to £6.2.5 per week.

In addition the whole of the Timber, Corrugated Sheets &c., are the property of the Council.

Councillor D. Hilley has examined every item of the A/c : the Sub Committee recommend that a separate Fund be opened in the Bank, the A/c EXXX to be paid by an overdraft & the money as received be banked & the Balance, after disposal of the Timber &c. paid to the Council.

The Committee are indebted to Councillor W.L. Jenkins for sending horse, wagon & men to remove Hurdles which are being stored in Broadway Barn.

The Chairman wishes to thank the members of the Sub. Committee for the assistance they have rendered him.
