Testament of me James Simpson Ballard
of the Islands near Cowbridge in the County of
Glamorgan Esquire Colonel of the Royal Glamorgan
Artillery Militia. I give and devise my customary
or copyhold messuage or dwellinghouse buildings
farm lands and premises situate at and near
Hather in the Parish of Llanblethian in the
said County of Glamorgan and in the Manor
of Llanblethian known by the name of Fawley farm
including the lands purchased by my late father
of Richard Duck. I are gentleman and now hold
with the said farm also my late dwelling house
built on part of the said farm and now by
the occupation of Ann Lewis and William Simons
with the gardens thereunto belonging and also
all my freehold dwellinghouses or cottages and
gardens situate at c Hather apresaid and all other
my real property (if any) situate at or near Hather
apresaid and in the said Parish of Llanblethian
(but not dwellinghouses or premises situate in or near
Cowbridge) unto my nephew John Lovell (son of my
sister Lucy Lovell) his heirs and assigns for ever
I also give and devise all that my slice of
land containing by admeasurement twenty two acres
and three perches (b it more or less) situate in
the parish of Llanblethian afterward part of it having
been formerly part of a common called Lantre
now and part having been old enclosed land
with the affinements unto my said nephew
John Lovell his heirs and assigns for ever I
give and devise my undivided ^{one}/_{two} or equal
half part of and in all and several that
messuage tenement and lands known by the name

I record where in the Parish of Llanilltud in
the said County of Glamorgan with the
affurteances unto my nephew Charles Forester
(son of my sister Ellen Forester) his heirs and
assigns for ever I direct that all ~~my~~ debts
that may be due from me at the time
of my decease including debts on mortgage of all
or any part of my freehold copyhold or
leasehold estates or upon deposit of little
leads or other securities shall be paid out of
my personal estate and if my personal estate
should be insufficient then the deficiency
shall be paid out of my residuary real estate
hereinafter devised it being my Will and
intention that the hereditaments and premises
hereinafore devised to my said nephews John
Lovel and Charles Forester respectively should

III. go to them free from any mortgage or other
any wherethen the same hereditaments and premises may be sold or otherwise disposed of, the same shall not be liable for any debts and bequeath the residue
debt for which they shall not be answerable and bequeath the residue
and remainder of my real estate of every
description and the whole of my personal estate
of every description (subject to my debts as aforesaid)
unto my two sisters Eliza Lovell and Ellen
Forester their heirs executors administrators and
assigns according to the nature thereof respectively
absolutely in equal shares as tenants in
common and I hereby direct that the
shares of my said sisters in my said
residuary real and my said personal
estates shall be for their own separate use
respectively independently of any present or
future husband of them respectively I appoint
my said sisters Eliza Lovell and Ellen
Forester joint executors of this my Will
and hereby revoke all former Wills In witness

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whereof I have hereunto set my hand this eightth day of November One thousand eight hundred and eighty

To all to whom these presents shall come John Lovell of Bangalore in the Madras Presidency in the Empire of India Major in His Majesty's 21st Regiment of Hussars sends greeting Whereas the said John Lovell is under the Will of the late Colonel James Simpson Bullard late of Cowbridge in the County of Glamorgan South Wales in the United Kingdom now deceased entitled to a share in certain lands hereditaments and premises known as the "Carterthorn" estate and situate in the County of Glamorgan aforesaid and whereas necessity may arise for the said property to be sold and the said John Lovell is desirous of affording some person by act on his behalf during his absence from England in respect of such sale in case such necessity should arise as aforesaid now these presents witness that the said John Lovell doth hereby appoint Eliza Lovell widow of the late John Lovell now deceased & present residing at Flitbridge House Bath in the County of Somerset England to be his true and lawful Attorney for him and on his behalf and in his name to sell at such time or times as his said Attorney shall think fit

all the interest of him the said John Lovell

 "Hermitage" estate situate in the County of Glamorgan
 aforesaid and the inheritance thereof in full
 unto together or in lots and either by public
 auction or private contract and either with or
 without special conditions as to till or otherwise
 with liberty to buy in at any sale by auction
 to record or vary contracts for sale and to resell
 without being answerable for any loss arising thereby
 and also to execute such deed or deeds for
 conveying the said premises to any purchaser or
 purchasers thereof and also to give effectual receipts
 and discharges for the purchase moneys of the
 said premises as his said Attorney shall think
 fit and generally to execute and do all such
 deeds and things in relation to the premises as
 the said Attorney shall think expedient as fully
 and effectually as the said John Lovell could have
 done if personally present and the said John
 Lovell hereby empowers his said Attorney from
 time to time by any attested writing under her
 hand or substitute and appoint an Attorney or
 attorneys under her with the same powers as or
 with more limited powers than are hereinbefore
 expressed to be hereby given from time to time
 such substitute or substitutes at pleasure to name
 and another or others by such writing as last
 aforesaid he appoint and be the said John
 Lovell doth hereby ratify and confirm and declare
 for himself his heirs executors and administrators to
 ratify and confirm whatsoever his said Attorney
 or her substitute or substitutes shall do or
 cause to be done in or about the premises
 by virtue of these presents In witness

Chs05974-1 Will of John Simpson Ballard 1880 – 1889

JS Ballard of The Verlands, Colonel of the Royal Glamorgan Artillery.

Bequests of dwelling house, outbuildings etc in Aberthin known as Sweetings farm, dwelling house built as part of the farm (occupied by Ann Lewis and William), plus other houses/cottages in Aberthin (but not the houses etc in or near Cowbridge) to nephew John Lovell, son of his sister. Also lands in Llanblethian parish.

Also giving lands in Llanilid to nephew Charles Forester, son of his sister Ellen Forester of Sketty.

JS Ballard died in 1882 at the Verlands. Additional documents of 1884 and 1889 show the outcome of his bequests.
