

Listed buildings etc. in Aberthin – 1999 amendments

Grade II listed :

The Sweetings (including attached barn and stable range to the west) – listed for remaining 17th century structure.

Gate House and bridge at Ty Mawr (early 17th century) – fireplace & oven believed to remain in interior

Pen-y-Bryn, Pen y Lan Rd – early to mid 19th century thatched roof cover

Range of buildings at Court Farm – probably 19th century rebuilding of earlier structure, incorporating dressed medieval stonework, perhaps from Llanquian Castle. Ref : RCAHM, Glam. Inventory Vol. IV Part II

Telephone call box outside Farmers Arms – included for its contribution to the conservation area.

Grade II* listed :

Great House (Ty Mawr) – ‘a remarkably well preserved example of an early 17th century gentry house’. RCAHM inventory Ancient Monuments in Glamorgan Vol IV Part 1 1981 The Greater Houses
