Item (1)

A letter had been received from Glamorgan W.I. Markets Limited requesting a reduction on the fee for hiring on the basis that heating was not required during the period of the market.

The committee considered the matter and recommended that no reduction should be granted.

Item (2)

The committee discussed the outline of ideas for making better use of the room at the back of the Town Hall and providing better sanitary arrangements and in consequence of the council minute decided to ask Mr. Keith Evans to consider the project and to provide plans for the basis of discussion and an estimate for capital expenditure.

Item (3)

Further to the council minute authorising a fabric survey of the Town Hall to be carried out, it was agreed to ask Mr. Keith Evans to undertake this work also and to provide us with an estimate for capital expenditure.

Item (4)

Regarding the cells, it was agreed that in respect of the caretaker's corridor all the cells should be cleaned out and the cell nearest the caretaker's quarters used for Town Hall and caretaker's equipment, the next cell for use by various societies with weekly bookings and requiring a small amount of storage space, leaving the final two cells to be completely cleared and kept as showpieces.

The other corridor of cells to be completely cleared, washed out and the walls painted, following which a scheme for their use would be prepared.

The work involved would be carried out by outside staff when weather conditions were such that work outdoors was brought to a halt.

Item (5)

It was agreed that the cleaning of the pictures for the robing room should not be carried out by the committee, but by our outside staff, alternatively the caretaker could organise some help to assist her in the task.
