### ARMED & ARTISTIC: INTRODUCING RICHARD LUNT ROBERTS

Ymhlith uchafbwyntiau casgliadau Rhyfel Byd Cyntaf amgueddfa catrodol FfBC mae naw llyfr brasluniau artist. Roedd y llyfrau darluniau personol hyn ac ôl traul arnynt yn perthyn i Is-gapten Richard Lunt Roberts.

Ganed Lunt Roberts yn India yn 1894. Symudodd ei deulu i ogledd Cymru ac fe'i magwyd yn Llandudno. Pan gychwynnodd y Rhyfel Byd Cyntaf roedd yn aelod o Glwb Braslunio Llundain ac yn gweithio fel artist graffig.



Among the highlights of the RWF regimental museum's First World War collections are nine artist's sketch-books. These well-worn and personalized drawing books belonged to Lieutenant Richard Lunt Roberts.

Lunt Roberts was born in India in 1894. His family moved to north Wales and he grew up in Llandudno. At the outbreak of the First World War he was a member of the London Sketch Club and was working as a graphic artist.

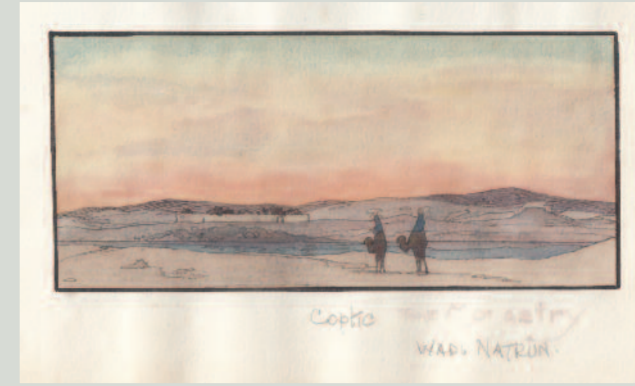


Ar Awst 27ain 1914 ymrestrodd fel milwr cyffredin yn 1/6ed FfBC yng Nghaernarfon a chafodd ei gomisiynu fel Ail Is-gapten ar 25ain Mehefin 1915. Tri mis yn ddiweddarach, dechreuodd ar ei daith i ddwyrain ardal Môr y Canoldir gan gyrraedd Gallipoli ar 7fed Hydref 1915.

Roedd y 6ed Bataliwn wedi cael ei anfon yn filwyr wrth gefn i geisio torri'r sefyllfa ddi-ddatrys yn ymgyrch y Dardanelles. Fodd bynnag, parhaodd y sefyllfa hon ac roedd Lunt Roberts ymhlith y nifer fawr o filwyr lluoedd y Cynghreiriaid a gafodd eu dal yn y llofygydd a'r stormydd eira ofnadwy ar 26ain a 27ain Tachwedd 1915.

On August 27th 1914 he enlisted as a private in the 1/6th RWF at Caernarfon and secured a commission as a Second Lieutenant on 25th June 1915. Three months later, he embarked for the eastern Mediterranean arriving in Gallipoli on 7th October 1915.

The 6th Battalion had been sent as reinforcements to break the deadlock in the Dardanelles campaign. The stalemate, however, continued and Lunt Roberts was one of the many Allied soldiers caught in the terrible floods and blizzards on 26th and 27th November 1915.

The 6th Battalion were based near the Coptic Monasteries at Wadi Natrun, Lower Egypt, March - May 1916.

Cafodd Lunt Roberts ei wacáu i'r Aifft a'i dderbyn mewn ysbyty yn Giza, Cairo, ar 4ydd Rhagfyr 1915. Fe iachodd a dychwelyd i'w ddyletswyddau gyda'i fataliwn yn gyflym iawn ac yn ystod y cyfnod hwn, ar ddechrau 1916, pan oedd y bataliwn yn ail-gryfhau ar ôl Gallipoli yr ailgydiodd yn ei gelf.

Lunt Roberts was evacuated to Egypt and admitted to hospital in Giza, Cairo, on December 4th 1915. He returned to health and duty with his battalion very quickly and it was during the downtime in early 1916, when the battalion was recovering from Gallipoli, that he returned to his art.

Roedd 6FFBC wedi'u lleoli ger Deir El Belah, i'r de o Gaza, Awst - Hydref 1917  
6RWF were based near Deir El Belah, south of Gaza, August - October 1917

Cofnododd Lunt Roberts fywyd y milwr gan gynnwys yr adegau hynny pan oedd milwyr yn gallu ymlacio yn ogystal â'r cyfnodau o bryder a thensiwn.

Lunt Roberts recorded life as a soldier including those times when soldiers could relax and those moments of anticipation and tension.



Mae'r llyfrau braslun yn cynnwys casgliad o'r dyluniasau beiddgar hyn sy'n dangos Eifftiaid yn y farchnadle a'r Corfflu Llafur Eifftiaid wrth eu gwaith.

The sketch-books include a suite of these bold designs featuring Egyptians in the market place and the Egyptian Labour Corps at work.

Mae ei sgil fel artist graffig proffesiynol yn amlwg yn yr amrywiaeth eang o gyfryngau ac ymagweddau a archwiliodd yn ei lyfrau brasluniau: pensil, pen ac inc, dyfrlliwiau, sialciau, creonau wrth iddo fraslunio a chreu tirluniau, portreadau, gwawdluniau, cartwnau, ffrisiau a phosteri.



Mae'r llyfrau brasluniau yn cynnwys ystod o bosteri teithio posibl.

The sketch-books contain a range of potential travel posters.

His skill as a professional graphic artist is apparent in the wide variety of media and approaches he explored in his sketch-books: pencil, pen and ink, watercolours, chalks, crayons as he sketched and created landscapes, portraits, caricatures, cartoons, friezes and posters.

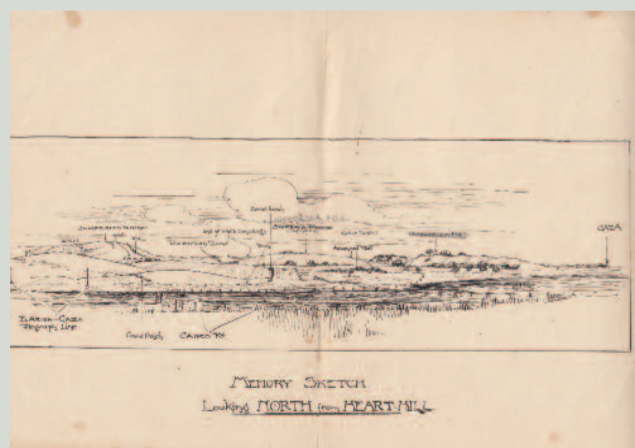

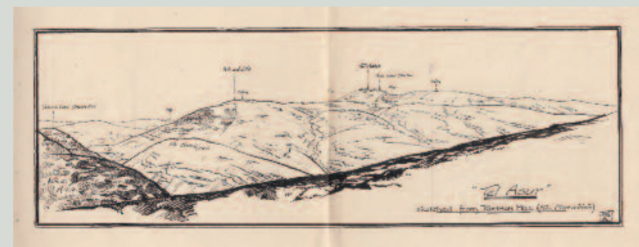
In later life, Lunt Roberts drew for *The Humourist* and *Punch* magazines. He supplied cartoons, silhouettes and caricatures for magazines and his former regiment's memorial books.

Rhoddodd Lunt Roberts hefyd ei sgiliau fel arlunydd at wasanaeth y fyddin. Cafodd hyfforddiant ar sut i ddefnyddio gwn periant a'r lleolwr pellter. Fel artist, roedd yn brofiadol wrth feirniadu pellter a phersbectif.



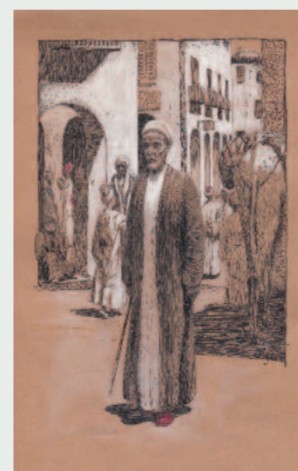

Lunt Roberts also put his skill as an artist at the service of the army. He trained in the use of the machine gun and the range finder. As an artist he was experienced in judging distance and perspective.

Ar adeg pan oedd rhai milwyr yn edrych i lawr eu trwynau ar 'frodorion', mae lluniau Lunt Roberts yn dangos parch at y bobl y daeth ar eu traws.

At a time when some soldiers looked down on the 'natives', Lunt Roberts's drawings reveal a respect for the people he encountered.



Yn dilyn y cadoediad ar 31ain Hydref 1918, teithiodd y 5/6ed Bataliwn i lawr y llinell o Ludd ym Mhalesteina i Kantara, gogledd-orllewin Sinai, cyn cyrraedd pen eu taith - Gwersyll Hadra, Alexandria. Er bod hyfforddiant a dyletswyddau gwarchod wedi parhau, roedd mwy o amser am chwaraeon, partion cyngerdd, dosbarthiadau addysgiadol a darlithoedd ar VD a dadfyddino. Archwiliodd Lunt Roberts gefn gwlad Yr Aifft a dinasoedd mawr Alexandria a Chairo. Mae ei arsylwadau o bobl a golygfeydd yn goroesi fel cofnod byw o'r Aifft ganrif yn ôl.

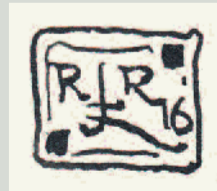
Following the armistice on 31st October 1918, the 5/6th Battalion travelled down the line from Ludd in Palestine to Kantara, north-west Sinai, before reaching their destination - Hadra Camp, Alexandria. Although training and guard duties continued, there was more time for sports, concert parties, educational classes and lectures on VD and demobilization. Lunt Roberts explored the Egyptian countryside and the great cities of Alexandria and Cairo. His observations of people and scenery survive as a vivid record of Egypt a century ago.

Lunt Roberts embarked at Port Said on 18th June 1919 for the journey home to Britain. On his return, he studied at the Leicester School of Art before resuming his career as a successful graphic artist. He worked for the Ministry of Information during the Second World War.

As a lieutenant in the Royal Welsh Fusiliers in the Great War, he was and we are fortunate that he survived, along with his sketch-books. He died in 1981.

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
